This application form can only be used if the marriage occurred in NSW. If you are the bride or groom, your marriage certificate can be issued to you. If you are a child of the bride or groom, the certificate can be issued to you if the bride and groom are deceased. If you are not a child of the bride or groom, but need to establish your legal right or entitlement, e.g. under a Will, your application will be considered.
